We embed our whole-systems ethos at includem, working collaboratively to ensure pathways of support for children, young people, families within their communities.

We know signposting often doesn't work. Children, young people and families can feel overwhelmed when exposed to a complicated landscape of services and multiple relationships. Through our relationship-based support we declutter the landscape. We remove barriers to access and facilitate engagement. We provide supports including mental health, financial-wellbeing, and housing, building supportive relationships beyond our engagement.

We work with partners organisations to increase their trauma informed practice and to reduce stigma in seeking support – ensuring that support is offered by the right people at the right time.
