Quick Wins

At the end of 2022, workshops took place between with the software developer to explore the HR and Learning & Developments of the current MAPS. Following these workshops there have been a few improvements made which we are calling "Quick Wins". You will see some of these new changes from the 6th February 2023.

These "Quick Wins", which will be detailed in future communications, will change the look and feel of MAPS in line with our branding and will also include some other quirky features which have been designed to help staff find and process information easier.

Some of these "Quick Wins" include:

- Branding Changes – including new logo and icon updates
- Supported Person List/Search View – including easier search functions for children, young people and families information showing more relevant information
- Supported Person Record amendments – including key information visible on main section
- HR Information – including key information visible for management of staff
- New System Admin Tasks – which include the facility for data cleansing for more accurate reporting information
