Here's just a small glimpse into what they've been up to this week;

Open Letters

This week, includem have co-signed the following Open Letters to both the candidates and the Scottish Government:

- <u>CPAG Scotland</u>: An Open letter to the three SNP Leadership candidates urging them to say what they'll do to meet Scotland's child poverty targets.
- OPFS: An Open Letter to the three SNP leadership candidates to ask if they will commit to making policies based on the principle that all families are treated equally, whatever their make-up.
- <u>CCPS:</u> Letter to the SNP leadership candidates to ask what their vision is to reform social care in Scotland.
- <u>Aberlour:</u> Letter to the Chancellor to use the budget to pause public debt recovery for those on low incomes & give them breathing space during the cost-of-living crisis.
